

Installing and configuring squirrelmail

Step 19 » Install squirrelmail using the below command. This will install apache and PHP packages.

```
$ sudo apt-get install squirrelmail
```

Step 20 » Configure squirrelmail

```
$ sudo squirrelmail-configure
```

Everything is pre-configured , we just need to change Organization name .

» Press 1 (Organization Preferences) » again press 1 (Organization Name) » Organization Name » Press S » Press Q to quit

Step 19 » Now configure apache to enable squirrelmail .

```
$ sudo cp /etc/squirrelmail/apache.conf /etc/apache2/sites-available/squirrelmail.conf
```

```
$ sudo a2ensite squirrelmail
```

Step 20 » Restart Apache service

```
$ sudo service apache2 restart
```

Step 21 » Now open **http://serverIP/squirrelmail** or **http://www.groupxx.com.bd** in your browser and login using username (bdnog6) . you can send and receive mail using squirrelmail.
